1. Pertisau, Austria

Ice-skating, snowtubing (sliding down slopes on inflated inner tubes), toboggan runs, great beginner runs near the village centre: this small, quiet resort is brilliant for kids. Higher up there are broad runs that are suited to those who have just found their ski legs – and there's a choice of seven ski schools for instruction including lessons from "Bobo the Penguin" for the very young.

Details: A week's full-board is from £1,060pp, or £415 per child aged 2-3, £582 aged 4-9, or £755 aged 10-15, with flights and transfers (01653 617000, inntravel.co.uk, achensee.info).
